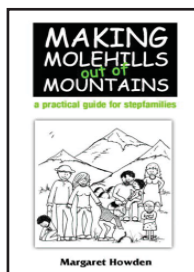

Practical advice is offered for: communication, stress - management, determining responsibilities, money and legal issues, helping grandparents and step-grandparents.

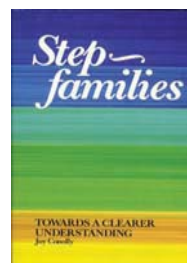

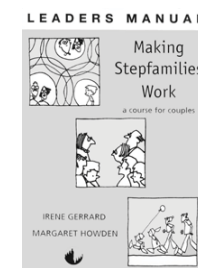
## Stepfamilies: Towards a Clearer Understanding - Joy Conolly

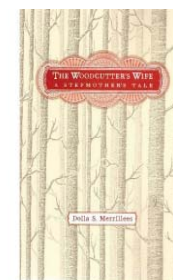
